2020 Call for Nominations: AIBC Lifetime Achievement Award

The AIBC Professional Recognition Committee welcomes nominations for the AIBC Lifetime Achievement Award. This award was established by AIBC Council to recognize **current or former Architects AIBC** who have made exceptional, sustained, and significant contributions to the profession of architecture in British Columbia through an outstanding career. One AIBC Lifetime Achievement Award may be bestowed annually, though an additional award may be bestowed posthumously.

Criteria

Candidates will be evaluated against the following criteria, respecting the body of work:

- spans an entire career, generally greater than 25 years;
- widely known for quality of design and contribution to the profession;
- of acknowledged distinction and has advanced the discipline of architecture, or endowed the profession of architecture in a distinguished manner; and
- recognized as being truly extraordinary and having enduring consequence.

Eligibility and Nomination Process

Award eligibility is open to **current or former Architect(s) AIBC individuals, duos or groups** (not including firms). The award may also be bestowed posthumously. Eligible candidates must be nominated by a minimum of five (5) current Architects AIBC in good standing. The submission must include a completed nomination form, one (1) letter of support from the nominators, explaining why the candidate(s) are being nominated. In addition, the submission must outline the nominee's or nominees' contribution(s) and must include a biographical profile (maximum 1,000 words), project descriptions and supporting documentation, including (but not necessarily limited to) letters from third parties, extracts from publications, and other awards.

Nomination Review Process

All nominations will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy and forwarded to the AIBC Professional Recognition Committee for its review and, if applicable, recommendation to AIBC Council.

Nomination Deadline

The nomination package (completed nomination form and submission), **must be received by the AIBC office before 4:30 p.m. on Friday, June 26, 2020**. The nomination package must be submitted electronically to Shawna Chilton, Manager of Human Resources and Administration (schilton@aibc.ca) **with all five nominators copied on the email**. In addition to the electronic submission, a hard copy version is also encouraged and can be sent to Shawna Chilton, Architectural Institute of B.C., 100–440 Cambie Street, Vancouver, B.C. V6B 2N5.
