2020 Call for Nominations: AIBC Special Recognition Award

The AIBC Professional Recognition Committee welcomes nominations for the *AIBC Special Recognition Award* (formerly the *AIBC Special Certificate of Recognition*). This award was established by the AIBC Council specifically to recognize those **individuals** or **firms** who have made exceptional, sustained and significant contributions to the practice or profession of architecture through professional and/or *pro bono* activities. This award may annually be bestowed upon multiple individuals and/or firms.

Criteria

The contribution will have been exceptional, sustained and significant. Nominations must be made by an Architect AIBC, other individual registrant or architectural firm, and must detail the candidate's professional and/or *pro bono* activities that benefit or enhance the practice or profession of architecture. The activities cited may have been made at the local, provincial or national level, and should demonstrate expertise and leadership in specific initiatives.

Eligibility and Nomination Process

Award eligibility is open to any **Architect AIBC, other individual registrant** or **architectural firm**. Eligible candidates must be nominated by three (3) Architects AIBC or other individual registrants in good standing, and nomination may be made with the support of an external professional group or representative with firsthand knowledge of the nominee's contribution. The submission must include a completed nomination form, one (1) letter of support from the nominators, explaining why the candidate(s) is being nominated. In addition, the submission must outline the nominee's or nominees' contribution(s) and include a biographical profile (maximum 1,000 words), professional and/or *pro bono* activity descriptions and any supporting documentation.

Nomination Review Process

All nominations will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy and forwarded to the AIBC Professional Recognition Committee for review and, if applicable, recommendation to AIBC Council.

Nomination Deadline

The nomination package (completed nomination form and submission), **must be received by the AIBC office before 4:30 p.m. on Friday, June 26, 2020**. The nomination package must be submitted electronically to Shawna Chilton, Manager of Human Resources and Administration (schilton@aibc.ca) **with all three nominators copied on the email**. In addition to the electronic submission, a hard copy version is also encouraged and can be sent to Shawna Chilton, Architectural Institute of B.C., 100–440 Cambie Street, Vancouver, B.C. V6B 2N5.
