Finish Architecture School

Complete a Canadian Architectural Certification Board (CACB) accredited architectural degree program and gain your CACB Academic Certification through your school.

2 Select a Mentor

You need to select a mentor in order to apply the Intern Architect Program (IAP). Your mentor will advise and guide you through the IAP. They must be an Architect AIBC or a Retired Architect AIBC.

Apply to be an Intern Architect AIBC Visit aibc.ca/iap. Download, complete and return the required IAP application package. After completing your four PD courses Apply to be an Architect AIBC and completing 85% of experience hours as per the IAP Manual, you can register for the Oral Upon successful completion of the national and Exam, which is held three (3) times each year. provincial registration requirements, you can apply to become a registered Architect. Approval takes approximately five (5) weeks.
